The 100,000 Strong in the Americas Innovation Fund is the dynamic public-private sector collaboration between the U.S. Department of State, Partners of the Americas, and NAFSA: Association of International Educators – leveraged by support from corporations, foundations, U.S. Embassies, universities, community colleges, and technical training institutions throughout the Western Hemisphere region.

Since its inception in January 2014, a total of 90+ Innovation Fund grants have been awarded to teams of 200+ higher education institutions from 20 countries in the Western Hemisphere. Innovation Fund grant winning partnerships between universities in the United States and higher education institutions in Latin America and the Caribbean are facilitating more student exchange and training opportunities as well as strengthening regional education cooperation and competitiveness throughout the Americas.

To date, PERU is in the top-five winning countries of the Western Hemisphere in this signature education initiative.
